As the Air Force's newest combat training system, the P5CTS provides a real time and rangeless air combat training to the 33rd Fighter Wing and the 53rd Test Squadron at Eglin AFB.

2. Specifically, I want to thank Mr. Walter Smith and his team for their dedicated efforts to find a communications solution to enable P5CTS Real Time Operations (RTO). The P5CTS was fielded at the 33rd in late January 2007 but due to shortages/incompatibilities in existing radios and communications equipment, was unable to be used for live RTO operations. Mr. Smith and his team worked diligently with our P5CTS Program Office and the 33rd Communications Shop to obtain the necessary equipment and integrate it into the P5CTS to provide a workable solution.
